Meeting called to order at 1002 Hrs.

A motion was made to accept the May 5, 2020 Minutes as written. The motion was made by Chief Painter, 2nd by Chief Lindner, No discussion, Approved by all, Motion passed.

A discussion was had by the members of the AHAC Board and the Prosecutors Office about the Lorain County All Hazards contract. This contract is reviewed every 4 years. It is set up differently for the Medina County proposal.

Lorain County does not attempt to receive back dues or cost of service.

Mike Lyons advised to present the Medina County contract to the Medina County Executive Board at their next meeting. Chief Haas supports what Mike Lyons is saying and it is in Christina Fozio hands to work with the Medina County Executive Board on this.

A continued lengthy discussion was had about allocations for the All Hazards Team. This discussion was talked about with the Prosecutors Office.

The Confined Space Ops class had been approved and waiting on the Grant Money. This class needs to be run by the end of June 2020 to receive the Grant money. The class will be held on June 13, 20 and 27, 2020 at Medina Station #1.

Wally advised he bought a 2 wheel dolly for the boat motors that the Team received from the SERT Water Rescue Team. Chuck Stiver will fabricate this dolly so that the motors will hang off of it.

Wally also advised that all portable generators, the air compressor, the power washer and the trash pump have been serviced.

Wally stated that he taught an impromptu Trench Rescue training class to the Medina County Line Workers in Valley City. Wally and Ryan Goff, who is the safety/HR person for County Maintenance, worked together to teach this training. Wally will also be teaching another class in October 2020 to other Line Workers.
