The Chlorine meter for Hazmat has been ordered. It will be here in the next 7-10 days from Fire Safety Services.

The PID Meter has been repaired by Matt Sturgeon. He took care of this matter while Wally was out with his mom in the hospital and funeral. Matt was able to get a new O2 sensor and found that the charging bank was not working correctly and was able to fix it. It was cheaper to try and fix it then spend \$4000.00-\$6000.00 for a new meter and charging bank.

Wally states that the Team leaders want to purchase equipment from their 2019 Budget.

Chief Painter received a phone call from Tom Bartfai and Tom stated he will be the interim until a permanent Team Leader is chosen. A motion was made by Christina Fozio to make Tom Bartfai interim, 2nd by Chief Erskine. No discussion. Approved by all. Motion passed.

Chuck Cali:
