- Ben discussed plans for the LEPC All Hazards conference scheduled for March 21st at Buffalo Creek Retreat. It is a joint conference with Summit County.
- Ben mentioned that we are beginning to plan an exercise for this spring. There will be more information at the next meeting.
- Ben gave an update on the volunteer programs. Members of ARES have submitted applications, received background checks and have been hired at Medina County EMA volunteers as members of the newly formed Communications Unit. The Sheriff was thanked for performing the background checks for no charge.

- Matt gave an update on the CERT program. Ben & Matt have both attended the train the trainer class in Columbus. CERT activities are currently on hold. Matt is working on a program plan and plans on CERT resuming activities in February.

Greg Smith

- Greg is pleased that the All Hazard trailers are now stored inside at the Montville Service Garage. This is the first winter that they are inside. It will eliminate having to deal with frozen locks and improve response times.
- Greg spoke about a patient that was seen at Medina ED after being contaminated with hydrofluoric acid. He said everything went well. Anthony Dattilo also gave the group an explanation of hydrofluoric acid.

- Fred said Ohio's one call system for spill reporting is up and running. It is for state agencies only and does not include notifying the counties.

- Brad said the FBI is continuing to focus on identifying toxic chemicals and chemicals that can be used as explosive precursors in the area. They are also looking for sources of biological agents and potential food and water targets.

- Mike is working on a safety procedure policy for his drivers. He is making a plan that lists available shelters the drivers could use during a tornado warning.
