- The hazmat team passed the typing audit Dec 17 to become a type II team again. It will be formally approved at next week's tac meeting.

Christina Fozio

- EMA has taken possession of the old Lafayette fire station on Heather Hedge. Currently the donated Sharon twp. Squad for water rescue, F-550 & the gooseneck trailer purchased with CARES funds, and mobile command are stored at the building. There is also tow motor purchased on CARES used for moving PPE.
- We originally received \$400,000 on the 2018 capital grant for a building. We just received the 2020 capital grant for another \$400,000. EMA also has \$100,000 from NEXUS. We are looking into expanding the building up instead of out now that we have additional funds. EMA is also looking into the old baker building.

- Regarding vaccine planning, EMS providers were the first to receive it. 142 EMS providers received it on the 23rd and 24th of December.

Matt Sturgeon

- EMA volunteers were requested to provide logistics support for the drive through vaccine clinics including one yesterday. There is currently one more scheduled that we have been requested to support.

Colin Johnson

- Planning efforts for the vaccine clinics is ongoing. The Health Department has clinics this week on Wednesday, Thursday, Friday, & Saturday. Phone calls are nonstop for people that want to be vaccinated. More clinics will be scheduled as vaccine becomes available. Currently working on 1A group, will be starting 1B group next.
