One-day response and one recovery in the EOC. This will be a good exercise for EMA because it allows us to play in it which does not happen very often.
- The MOU has been signed for use of the Montville building for storage of All Hazard equipment. They are currently working on getting electric run to the building.
- On October 28<sup>th</sup> EMA will be participating in the Westfield Group SWAT exercise. Christina is going to be one of the bad guys.

- We are working on organizing the annual All Hazards Conference. It will be held the first half of November; the date has not been set. Westfield Insurance will host it.

  - C.A.R.E will be participating in the Summit County shelter exercise on October 1<sup>st</sup>

- Dave Rickon (ARES)
  - EMA is now a member is SHARES. It is a government program that uses high frequency radio communications. We now have use of the federal frequencies that are outside of the amateur band. We were issued a SHARES call sign and can use the current equipment in the radio room. There are weekly checks. SHARES stations in the SE and W are ask to monitor due to the hurricanes.
  - ARES members participated in the Buckeye Breakaway bike ride. There were approximately 600 bikers that rode from Brunswick to Ashland then back again. The organizers handed out MARCS radios that were used for the event.

  - Everyone survived the RNC. The All Hazards center was stood up on Saturday to handle everything WMD related. Everyone is very happy with how the week ended up. Outside agencies were able to work very well with Cleveland Fire.

  - The Medina County Health Department was just awarded a mosquito grant from Ohio EPA. It provides the health department with the ability to handle any type of mosquito outbreak.
