#### Spill Reports

- OEPA
  - 8 Incident report in Medina County (July-August)
  - Ron talked about the transformer fire at the National Guard armory on Lafayette. The contractor has removed the non-PCB transformers. About 5 gallons was consumed by fire. Ron also spoke about the Marathon incident and an incident in Lodi with a small amount of fuel in a pond.
- LEPC
  - 7/6/21 429 S Court, fuel in creek, unknown quantity dumped in storm drain at Marathon. MFD, Hazmat, EMA, OEPA responded.
  - 7/30/21 125 gallons diesel fuel on roadway and ditch from saddle tank. MFD, OEPA responded

Ben introduced resolution 2021-15. This resolution is to submit the hazmat plan as written with no changes. We are allowed to submit the plan with no changes for 3 years, this is the third year. Next year will be a plan revision.

#### Hazmat Update

- Greg and Tom conducted a decon training at Lodi Hospital for Lodi Fire, Hazmat, Medina County Water Rescue Team, and the Wooster Twp Dive Team. This was in preparation for the exercise. There will be a second decon training at Medina Hospital with Medina FD.

#### All Hazards Station 1 Update

- Negotiations are in progress with Webber Murphey Fox, they were the architect firm selected by the executive board. Construction is not expected to start until Spring.

#### Full Scale Exercise

- The design team met last night with the contractor who is designing and facilitating the exercise. There will be a training & tabletop exercise on Family Assistance Centers on Friday October 15<sup>th</sup> followed by the first responder portion of the exercise on Saturday October 16<sup>th</sup>. The Saturday exercise will involve a semi leaking a chemical in the parking lot in the Lodi Outlet Mall, which created an MCI in the mall area and a water/dive rescue in a pond. The LEPC is invited to observe.
