LEPC Compliance Report – for SFY 2010

- This is the update of the number of hazardous and extremely hazardous facilities that have reported to the LEPC as required, and the number of compliance activities completed by the LEPC.

SERC Grant Financial Status Report – SFY 2010

- The only carry over we have left is \$4,803.00.

Anhydrous Ammonia Tank Updates – reported by Buck Adams

- We have received the final drawings for the tank so we can correctly model the plumes.
- There was minimal change in distance and population for the valve size at 1.25", 1", and .75".
- The installation does not require an electrical or zoning inspection.
- The Dept of Ag. And vendor of tank will initially inspect tank and components.

New Business – report by Buck Adams

- We have received an PUCO grant to fund (2) All Hazards IMT training classes at the University Center.
- Currently we are looking for instructors and each class will consist of 24-32 people.
- The target audience is fire, ems, law enforcement, hospitals, and health depts..
- The target dates are Sept and Nov.
