All meeting attendees introduced themselves

Greg Smith – The Medina County Hazmat Team had 5 incidents since the last meeting. 1 was a full team response for an above ground fuel oil tank leaking in Chatham. There was a phone consult with Hinckley and Sharon and another fuel oil leak in Lodi. Greg spoke about the Hazmat Conference he just attended. We also just hosted 2 hazmat IQ classes with a total of 41 attendees. He would like to host the class again, it provides first responders with confidence to deal with hazmat incidents. He discussed Methyl Mercaptan separating from natural gas.

Christina Fozio- We are working on the EOP, changing from ERF's to ESF's. We are also looking for a third full time staff member. We have put together a draft pipeline response plan. We are also working on a joint LEPC conference which will be on Oct 22nd at Summit County's new Health Department. Tony will be one of the speakers. We are hosting G290/291 PIO Series on July 14, 15, & 16. We are starting discussions on a tabletop exercise for FY2016. We are also working on the 100% Flood Mitigation Assistance Grant buyout for the River Styx Rd house.

Tony Datillo – Spoke about his plans for the conference. He said his presentation will be about hazardous waste and will be interactive. He wants to talk about all the issues.

Joe Cavaretta – Introduced Bethany Minor who was an intern and is now a volunteer. Joe will be leaving his position at the Red Cross on July 17th to move back home and start a new job. He thanked everyone in Medina County for their help over the years. The Red Cross currently has a home fire preparedness campaign and is installing smoke detectors in homes.

Allice Strogin – C.A.R.E. was at Westfield safety day. They now have 2 O2 tanks to use with their pet O2 masks, so they do not need to rely on using one from a squad.

Sue Watkins – There have been 9 incidents. Reports given to MCEMA. There have been some changes with OEPA, they are now more organized.

Mark Albrecht – Told Christina she did an awesome job on the pipeline plan.

Colin Johnson – Received some calls for flood cleanup. They are working on accreditation in July.
