The Medina County LEPC Meeting was called to order at 8:34am.

A motion to approve the July 1, 2010 meeting minutes was made by Mike Kollert, seconded by John Gotheridge, and unanimously approved by all.

Correspondence – Reported by Shandra and Christina

The Medina County LEPC received the Excellence Award of \$5,000 for the 16 county exercise held in March 2010. The after action meeting for the Beach Rd tanker incident will be on September 14 in the Medina Co. EMA EOC at 10am. Buck, Shandra, and Bill Thorn will be meeting to go over the plume modeling for the anhydrous ammonia tank on Beach Rd. in anticipation that it may go to court. Christina reports that the EMPG has gone up from \$84,000 to \$97,000 this year. Buck is looking at using the Beach Rd. incident as the LEPC's full scale exercise.

Old Business – Alliss reporting on C.A.R.E. activities

C.A.R.E. volunteers helped the Summit County Animal Shelter move to their new facility on Aug. 21st. C.A.R.E. and the Summit Co. EMA used the move as an evacuation drill, moving 85 cats and 36 dogs. There was an article in the Akron Beacon Journal about the move. Also, C.A.R.E. held a dog pool party fundraiser on Aug. 23rd, and they made \$700.

New Business – There was an inquiry about the bed bug problem. No warnings or alerts reported.

Once Around –

The LEPC welcomed Debbie Poland from Red Cross to the committee. She has taken over for Ron Hager.

Greg Smith from Medina Hospital reports that the Ohio Hospital Association has formed a committee and hired a contractor to plan for a pandemic, which from start to finish should take a year.

Sheriff Hassinger reports that they have ordered the new SWAT vehicle and it will take 6 months to complete with a cost of \$241,000, \$90,000 of which came from EMA and the rest is from drug money.

Mike Kollert from WRH reports that they are planning for an MCI drill with Seville/Guilford Fire EMS that will take place on October 28, 2010.

Chris Haley from Lodi Hospital reports they also are planning for an MCI to take place in November, participants include Lodi, Sullivan, and Westfield Fire/EMS.

Jean Daniel from the MC Health Dept reports they are still flu planning, and there will be only one shot this year.

Ron Fodo from EPA has handed in spill reports to the LEPC.

A motion to adjourn the MC LEPC meeting at 9:00am was made by John Gotheridge, seconded by Mark Albrecht and approved by all.
