Mr. Sarnowski called the meeting to order at 8:30 AM.

The radios will be used by the swift water team to avoid damage to more expensive radios. The vests will be kept by the swift water team for use by on-scene support personnel. The Wireless 911 Committee is reengaged because of changes in the ORC and a desire to route calls directly to appropriate dispatch centers. Both the Planning and Technical Committees are being reestablished. The township association appointed Director Fozio to represent the townships on the Planning Committee and Matt Neil to represent the townships on the Technical Committee. However, the board had a conversation regarding who seated members on each committee should be per ORC; it seems the Planning Committee representative should be a township trustee with EMA already having an appointed seat on the Technical Committee per the ORC. Hiscock said he will read the code again to verify who the proper seated members should be.
